A RESOLUTION OF THE CHESTER PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT'S FIRE DEPARTMENT IDENTIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT RESPONSE AWAY FROM THEIR OFFICIAL DUTY STATION AND ASSIGNED TO AN EMERGENCY INCIDENT.

WHEREAS, the Chester Public Utility District, Fire & Ambulance Service is a public agency located in the County of Plumas, State of California, and

WHEREAS, it is the Chester Public Utility District's desire to provide fair and legal payment to all its employees for time worked; and

WHEREAS, the Chester Public Utility District has in its employ, Fire District response personnel that include: Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Assistant Chief, Division Chief, Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Lieutenant, Engineer, Apparatus Operator, Equipment Operator, Firefighter/Paramedic, Firefighter/EMT, Firefighter; and

WHEREAS, the Chester Public Utility District will compensate its employees portal to portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, the Chester Public Utility District will compensate its employees overtime while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response.

Now, Therefore, Be It Hereby resolved by the Chester Public Utility District that:

- 1. Personnel shall be compensated according to Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Personnel Rules and Regulations, and/or other directive that identifies personnel compensation in the workplace.
- 2. In the event a personnel classification does not have an assigned compensation rate, a "Base Rate" as set forth in an organizational policy, administrative directive or similar document will serve to compensate such personnel.
- 3. The Chester Public Utility District's Fire & Ambulance Division will maintain a <u>current</u> salary survey or acknowledgement of acceptance of the "base rate" on file with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Fire Rescue Division.
- 4. Personnel will be compensated (portal to portal) beginning at the time of dispatch to the return to jurisdiction when equipment and personnel are in service and available for agency response.

5.	Fire department response personnel include: Fire Chief, Deputy Chief, Assistant Chief, Division Chief, Battalion Chief, Fire Captain, Lieutenant, Engineer/Apparatus/Equipment Operator, Firefighter/Paramedic, Firefighter/EMT, Firefighter.
